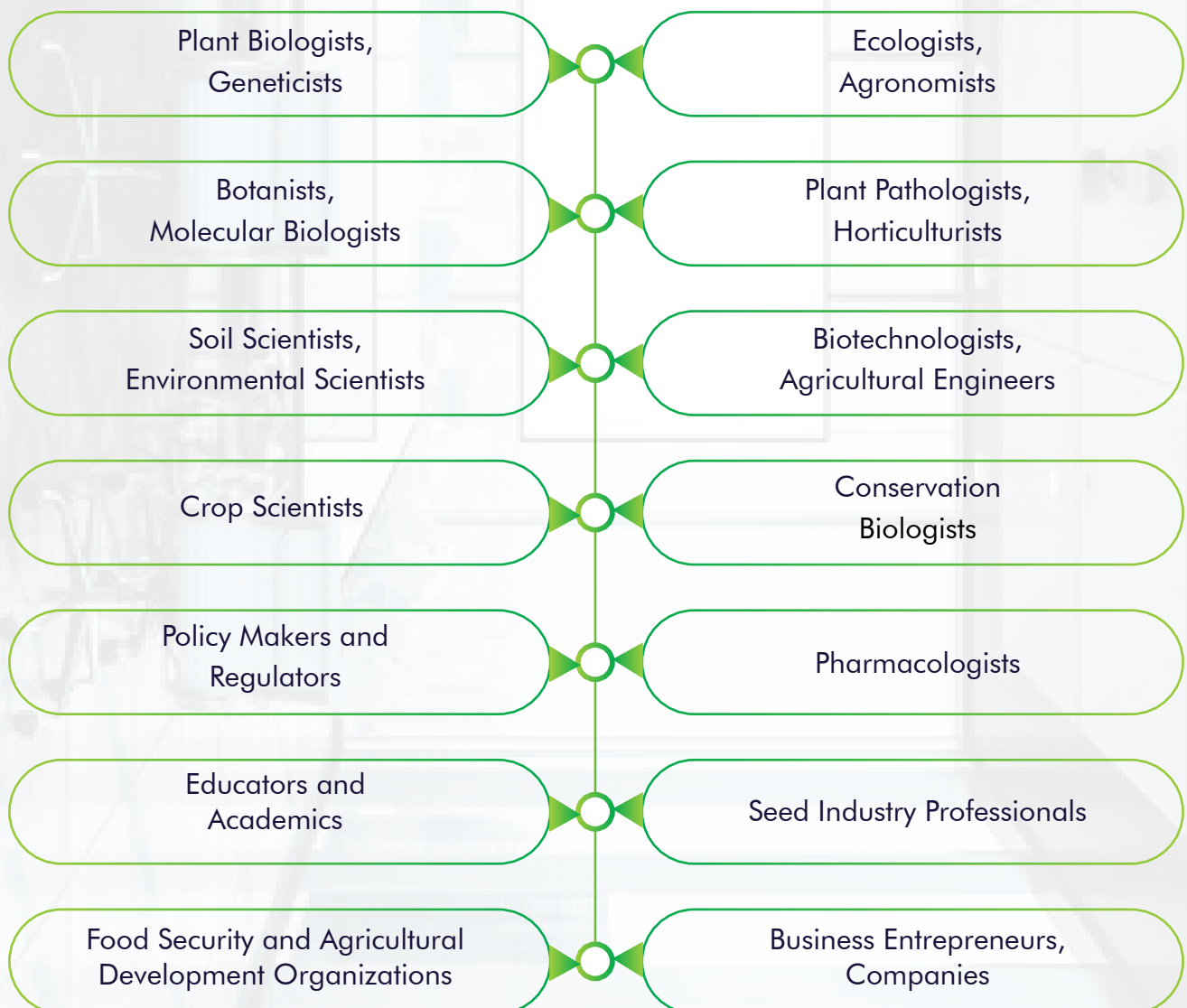

Welcome to the 3rd World Congress on Advances in Plant Science and Plant Biology July 12-13, 2027, Paris, France.

We now face enormous challenges, not least global warming which, as part of anthropogenically-induced climate change, is now threatening human survival across the globe. Increased episodes of heat stress, combined with droughts, wild fires, are affecting not just human health, but the agricultural basis of our essential foods. It has become incumbent on the scientific community to address the causes of current climate change and to seek both top-down and grass-roots solutions.

Much of the blame for today's climate change is laid on the emissions of fossil-fuel derived greenhouse gases and especially CO₂. However, we have increasing evidence that the spate of deforestation, especially in the humid tropics, is equally to blame, not just from the combustion and consequent escape of greenhouse gases, but from changes to the hydrological cycle. The high rate of transpiration, especially from angiosperm species, plays an extraordinary role in cooling the planetary surface. Furthermore, the forest-induced hydrological cycle, via atmospheric rivers, affects rainfall across continents and helps to temper climate processes. The energies involved in forest transpiration exceed by two orders of magnitude the solar energy taken up in photosynthesis and the capture of CO₂.

It has become clear that the pursuit of zero-emission policies will not on its own achieve sufficient cooling to offset global warming, now exceeding 1.5°C. In addition to zero-emissions, we need urgently to recover tropical rainforests, combining such regeneration with carefully-managed agroforestry. Grass-roots, even indigenous, knowledge, with good science must come to the fore in order to bring about an intelligent response and action.

This conference, with experts in Plant Science and Plant Biology, with special reference to the important role that plants play in cooling the surface and bringing about a sustainable hydrological cycle, will focus on the solutions and methodology required for forest regeneration and an associated agroforestry. Such a forum will, hopefully, spur the development of research-based solutions for efficient and innovative means of ensuring food safety and security, foster networking, and provide ambiance for researchers, scientists, students, and industry professionals.
