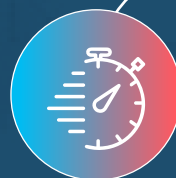

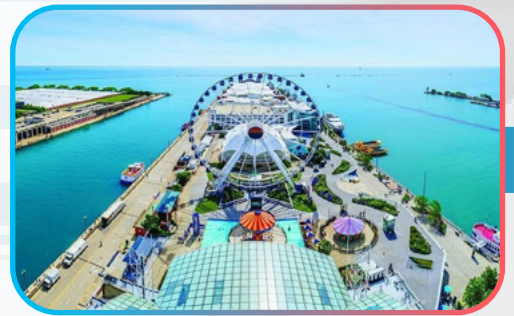
CHICAGO

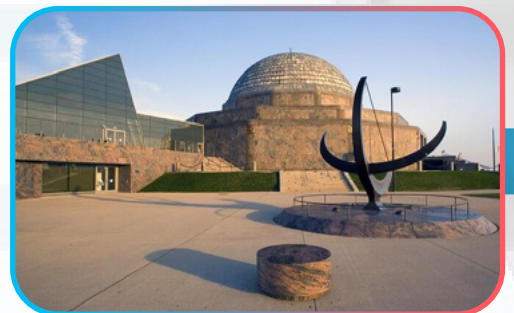
